Findings:

BONES:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There is seen fracture of the anterior and posterior columns of the left acetabulum at their base with resultant medial displacement of the medial wall of the left acetabulum. Mild central dislocation of the left femur is also noted. • There is a fracture of the posterior lip of the left acetabulum. • There is a fracture of the left inferior pubic ramus adjacent to the symphysis pubis. • Linear, vertically oriented, undisplaced fracture of the body of S1 vertebra is noted, to the right of the midline.
JOINT:	The visualized right hip joint is unremarkable.
SOFT TISSUES:	The visualized muscles are unremarkable.
FLUID:	No joint effusion is seen.
OTHER	None.

Impression	The CT Scan features suggest fractures of the anterior and posterior columns of the left acetabulum with medial displacement of the medial wall of the left acetabulum and mild central dislocation of the left femoral head in the left acetabulum as described. Fracture of the posterior lip of the left acetabulum, left inferior pubic ramus and the body of S1 on right is also noted.
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
